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

SENS is a piece for 4 performers (dancers and musicians) of different generations and from different worlds. SENS has been choreographed by Thomas Guerry, within the sound universe of Clément Ducol. This has been thought like a game that chooses the senses rather than the logic.

What if the concern of the play is not about trying to understand its meaning but to lose it? ... only feeling, letting it go, considering new perspectives because in fact, there are so many...
In his new creation, Thomas Guerry offers an experience over time, which starts by a short film that each spectator will watch before the show. So everyone will experience and see the show with memories in common. Thomas Guerry imagines the bodies as memories resonators.

We will embark with the main character in his search for meaning, through his intimacy and the meetings he had experienced during his life. We will see him on stage at an advanced age, facing his reminiscence in which we will travel, in an absurd world where anything seems possible.

SENS is a show that mixes the senses, during which we do not expect to see what we see, and to hear what we hear. SENS disturbs our way to perceive things, encouraging us to let go and to trust these new senses.

Synopsis

Claude is nine.

An age when everything hinges because everything is a game. An age when the blurred border between dreams and reality, gives a magical aspect on how we see life.

Claude is nine. A child like others. Almost.

Because Claude can hear everything. Always, a lot.

This hyperacusis makes him see life postponed from its soundtrack.

Claude is nine and all the ages that follow. And it is through the use of his ear, like others through their instinct, that he will choose his own way.

A life full of beautiful encounters and intense moments; which are greater and more colored thanks to their amplified sound.

Claude has been nine for a long time. And if life becomes too loud, he flees into his memories he makes dance with each others, like an endlessly reinvented melody.

About Arcosm

Originally created by Thomas Guerry & Camille Rocailleux, the company is, since 2016, directed by Thomas Guerry only.

Each production led by Arcosm reflects a desire to bring together strong personalities and universes. Since its creation in 2001 in Lyon, the choreographer Thomas Guerry likes working with new collaborators as new artistic projects are created. Dancers, set designers, musicians, actors, and costumers work together towards a poetic universe 'creation where dance and other artistic forms are mixed.'

The company main objective is to build bridges between different artistic disciplines and languages; music, dance and singing are the root of this artistic approach. The main elements of the human voice (rhythm, melody, timbre and tone) are closely linked to the musical world, and give vividness and theatricality to the characters.

The artists are required to use their personal skills and competences but also to explore less-familiar areas of artistic expression. Combined with highly-mastered techniques, these new ways of expression create the sensitive and emotional breaks the company is looking for in order to achieve its artistic aims.

Thomas Guerry call on multi-skills performers in order to deal with several topics, like resilience and failure (BOUNCE! 2013), our relationships to images (SUBLIME and SUBLIMINAL 2015 &2016), going over the meaning (SENS, 2018 creation) with humour and sometimes in a farcical way, in order to create total performances. With its 8 plays, the company highlighted several aspects of the human conditions, and the feelings we are going through life with some distance and self-mockery.

Curiosity is at the heart of our artistic approach, it enables us to bring together areas of expression which are usually distant from each other. We do not intend to conform to the recognized rules. Our wish is to broaden the artistic perspective without following a pre-establish vision.

Thomas GUERRY – *Staging & choreography*

Born in 1978. He graduated from the Conservatoire National de Région de Lyon, then from the Conservatoire National Supérieur de Musique et de Danse de Lyon. He improved his training with Odile Duboc, Fabrice Ramalingom, Hélène Cathala, Betty Jones etc.


He joined the Skanes Dance Theatre in Sweden in 1999. He danced in Meublé Sommairement (2000) and in Matière Première (2002), produced by the association Les Carnets Bagouets; in Les allées et Venues (2000) and Dehors (2002), produced by La Veilleuse/Christine Jouve Co. He danced with Bernard Glandier in Le Roi des Bons, Thomas Lerbrun in On prendra bien le temps d'y être, in 2001, La Trêves in 2004, What you want in 2006 and in Switch (2007).

He founded the Arcosm Co in 2000 with Camille Rocailleux and created ECHOA in November 2001. He took part in the choreography of the performance Carnets de notes for the Odysee Ensemble (2003). He choreographed the solo for the State Diploma with Sylvie Giron.

In 2006, Camille Rocailleux and he created the show LISA for the Arcosm Co. Two years later, he was invited by the association Les Carnet Bagouet to stage again for Les Ballets de Nancy another play of their repertoire: Les petites pieces de Berlin. The Ensemble Odyssée Co also called him to stage their new show Le concert interdit.

In 2009, Rocailleux and he started the new show to be produced by the Arcosm Co: La Mécanique des Anges. Since then he created with Camille Rocailleux 4 other pieces : TRAVERSE (2010), SOLONELY (2012), BOUNCE! (2013), SUBLIME (2015), SUBLIMINAL (2016).

His last performance SENS premiered in November 2018.



In 2014, he staged the play «ET POURQUOI PAS LA LUNE» writes by Cédric Marchal. 2014 is also the opportunity for Thomas to act for the first time as a comedian in the performance « Là Haut » of the author and director Hugo Paviot.

He co-wrote a feature film scenario entitled La boite en Fer Rouge with Bertrand Guerry. He also worked with his brother on the scenario of the feature film Mes Frères. His choreographic experience can be seen through the sharp vision of the destruction of main character's body. He played the part of Eddy, one of the main character. Shooting happened at Autumn 2016.

Clément DUCOL – *Musical composition*

Clément was born in 1981 and started to learn music through singing, cello and piano. At 11 he signed his first contract with Peter Brook for his show Impressions de Pelléas. He then got trained to percussions and orchestration and eventually he joined the Conservatoire Supérieur de Musique et de Danse de Lyon.

After he had graduated, he joined the Arcosm company so as to take over one character and for the creation of two shows (ECHOA, La Mécanique des Anges and TRAVERSE) as a percussionist and he was trained to dancing by Thomas Guerry. Aside, he played drums on Jérôme Van den Hole and arranges some of his eponym album's songs.

In 2009, he met the singer Camille, toured with the Music Hole show and arranged her last album Ilo Veyou, of which he composed and realized some of the songs (official release on September 2011). As an eclectic musician, he also plays on a regular basis with the contemporary music band 2E2M.





Noémie ETTLIN Danseuse

Née à Neuchâtel en Suisse, Noémie Ettlin a suivi la formation du « Marchepied » à Lausanne avant d'intégrer en 2007 le programme européen « D.A.N.C.E. » basé en Allemagne. Elle y rencontre les chorégraphes William Forsythe, Wayne McGregor, Angelin Preljocaj et Frédéric Flamand. Elle est alors soutenue par la bourse du Pour-cent culturel Migros qu'elle obtient sur concours deux années de suite.

En 2009, elle intègre le Ballet National de Marseille où elle interprète des pièces de Frédéric Flamand, Emmanuel Gat, Michèle Noiret, Thierry Malandain, Annabelle López Ochoa, Yasuyuki Endo,...

De 2012 à 2014 elle participe à la dernière création de James Thierrée, *Tabac Rouge*, qui sera suivie d'une tournée internationale. Elle travaille également avec des comédiens sous la direction de Denis Podalydès, Olivier Brunhes ou encore Raphaël Trano ainsi qu'avec la compagnie Tango Ostinato et la chorégraphe Laura Scozzi. Elle danse actuellement dans la dernière production du Théâtre de Suresnes, chorégraphiée par Andrew Skeels. Elle intègre la compagnie Arcosm avec *Subliminal*. Aujourd'hui Noémie apprécie rencontrer et explorer les nombreux univers qui gravitent autour de la danse et participe à des projets variés.

Matthieu BENIGNO Musicien

C'est d'abord par le violon que Matthieu découvre la musique à l'âge de sept ans au Conservatoire de Nice. Depuis longtemps attiré par l'univers éclectique et ludique de la percussion, il décide à seize ans de s'inscrire dans la classe

de Jacques Carré. Il obtient en 2006 son diplôme d'études musicales avec mention très bien au Conservatoire de Nice. Pendant cette période, il est musicien supplémentaire dans l'Orchestre Régional de Cannes et effectue plusieurs remplacements à l'Orchestre Philharmonique de Nice. En 2007, Matthieu entre au Conservatoire de Lyon jusqu'en 2010. Il est professeur de percussions et de batterie dans la région lyonnaise, et compose des pièces de théâtre musical pour ses élèves jusqu'en 2010, date à laquelle il décide de mettre davantage l'accent sur sa carrière de musicien. Ayant toujours été intéressé par le mélange des genres et des pratiques artistiques, il prend des cours de clown, de théâtre burlesque et de danse contemporaine pour élargir sa formation. En 2010, il intègre la compagnie Arcosm, pour le spectacle *TRAVERSE*, qui lui permet de se produire dans des théâtres et des festivals en France et à l'étranger. En Janvier 2012, il crée son premier spectacle, *Black Box*, avec deux artistes - Alexandre Esperet et Antoine Noyer, formant avec lui la compagnie Kalhua.

Mychel LECOQ danseur & musicien

Mychel Lecoq, né à Paris en 58, toujours en vie. Commence très tôt à se demander quoi faire avec les barils vides de lessive « Skip » grand format cylindrique. En constitue une batterie autodidactique. Et c'est parti : études de percussionniste.

Puis... s'ennuie d'être trop souvent assis : formation éclectique de danseur. Puis, rencontre avec la chorégraphe Maguy Marin, et c'est vraiment parti : le mouvement, le texte, la musique : 20 années de créations au sein de sa compagnie, dont la création de *May B* en 1981. Puis, 2 enfants... le mouvement, les textes, les musiques avec d'autres artistes qui cherchent sous la peau ce qui fait frémir la vie, les gens, la poésie.

Tom GUICHARD danseur

Issu du Break, il développe une danse métissée autour des techniques et des énergies du break avec une sensibilité et une influence marquée pour la danse contemporaine et le travail de sol. Son parcours commence par le break et l'univers des battles.

En 2012, il participe à un projet encadré par la Cie Chriki'Z / Amine Boussa et chorégraphié par Jeanne Azoulay. En 2014, il intègre la formation Révolution (Anthony Egéa) pour deux années intensives basées sur le mélange du hip hop et des danses académiques. En parallèle, son parcours professionnel prend un nouveau tournant lors de sa collaboration avec le jeune chorégraphe Nicolas Sannier qui aboutit sur le duo « Le Syndrome de Peter ». En 2016, il fait la rencontre de Milène Duhamel / Cie Daruma pour une reprise de rôle dans la pièce *La conférence dansée : Hip-hop(s) or not ?*. En 2017, il présente un solo au concours national UPPA qui lui vaut un second prix ; il rejoint la Cie Yann Lheureux sur la création *Gravity 0* et la Cie Malka dans la pièce *Têtes d'Affiche*. Aujourd'hui, il poursuit sa collaboration avec la Cie Chriki'Z autour de deux projets, la création franco-algérienne *Rouge Jaune Bleu* d'Amine Boussa et le trio De(s) Formés dirigé par Jeanne Azoulay. Egalement impliqué dans la transmission, il anime régulièrement des stages pour débutant et initiés.



Together, they will be able to do a lot.
